Why Consider SBA Guaranteed Loan?

- Longer maturity needed.
- Inadequate collateral.
- Broaden your lending to include businesses outside your normal bank policy such as startups, changes of ownership & higher turnover businesses.
- Active secondary market to help manage liquidity
- Lower down Payment (SBA requires at least 10% on start-up's)
